THE LAND ACQUISITION ACT, 1994

[SECTION 3(1)]

NOTICE OF LAND LIKELY TO BE REQUIRED FOR A PUBLIC
PURPOSE

NOTICE is hereby given that it appears to the President that the parcel of land described in the Schedule and known as Adventure (Schneider) Estate and situate in the Parish of St. Patrick, in the Ward of Tobago, is land likely to be needed for purposes which in the opinion of the President are public purposes:

- (a) Public housing development;
- (b) Establishment of Bethesda Government Primary School playing field and school garden;
- (c) Establishment of Social Care and Rehabilitation Facility;
- (d) Establishment of Bethesda Recreation Grounds and Community Centre; and
- (e) Establishment of Government Services:
 - Works Division Sub-office
 - Police Post
 - Fire Service Unit
 - Youth Empowerment Centre
 - Public Health Regional Building and Compound.

SCHEDULE

A parcel of land comprising 42 acres more or less, known as Adventure (Schneider) Estate and situate in the Parish of St. Patrick, in the Ward of Tobago, bounded on the north by Arnos Vale Road, on the south by the Great Courland River, on the east by the property of Lady Dorothy de Verteuil and on the west by Plymouth Road and said to belong now or formerly to Mr Joseph Schneider.
