THE LAND ACQUISITION (DECLARATION OF ACQUISITION)
(NO. 6) ORDER, 2001

Citation 1. This Order may be cited as the Land Acquisition (Declaration of Acquisition) (No. 6) Order, 2001.

Declaration of acquisition 2. The parcel of land—

(a) comprising together 5095.1 square metres more or less, situate south of Sumaria Trace, Charlieville, in the Borough of Chaguanas, in the County of Caroni;

(b) described in the Schedule and coloured raw sienna on a plan of survey signed by the Director of Surveys and dated 19th July, 1995 executed under Survey Order No. 57/92 and filed in the Lands and Surveys Division;

(c) having been declared by the President by Order by Legal Notice No. 166 of 1998 as land required for a public purpose and approved for such purpose by the Parliament of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago by Resolution of the House of Representatives on 20th November, 1998 and the Senate on 1st December, 1998 has been acquired for the following purpose: Highway Improvement.

SCHEDULE

Five parcels of land comprising together 5095.1 square metres more or less situate south of Sumaria Trace on the western side of the Uriah Butler Highway, Charlieville, in the Borough of Chaguanas in the County of Caroni and comprised as follows:

1. 1220.5 square metres more or less said to belong now or formerly to Zakir Mohammed;
2. 999.8 square metres more or less said to belong now or formerly to Zakir Mohammed;
3. 961.2 square metres more or less said to belong now or formerly to Boodoo Alladin and others;
