NOTICE OF LAND LIKELY TO BE REQUIRED FOR A PUBLIC
PURPOSE

NOTICE is hereby given that it appears to the President that the parcel of land described in the Schedule and situate at Trois Rivieres Estate, Speyside in the Ward of Tobago in the Parish of St. John is land likely to be needed for a purpose which in the opinion of the President is a public purpose: Construction of a secondary school under the Secondary Education Modernisation Programme (SEMP).

SCHEDULE

A parcel of land forming part of the Trois Rivieres Estate situate at Speyside, Tobago comprising approximately 10 acres more or less, bounded on the north by the river bordering the recreation ground, on the South by the remainder of the Trois Rivieres Estate, on the east by the Lucy Vale Road and a Road Reserve, forty (40) links wide, and on the west by the remainder of the Trois Rivieres Estate and said to belong now or formerly to Drayton and Clive MacDonald.
