THE LAND ACQUISITION (DECLARATION OF ACQUISITION)
(NO. 10) ORDER, 2001

Citation 1. This Order may be cited as the Land Acquisition (Declaration of Acquisition) (No. 10) Order, 2001.

Declaration of acquisition 2. The parcels of land—

- (a) comprising together 40.1062 hectares more or less, situate between the Tarouba Overpass, Tarouba, San Fernando and the Cross Crossing Roundabout in the Ward of Naparima in the County of Victoria;
- (b) described in the Schedule and coloured raw sienna on a plan of survey signed by the Director of Surveys and dated 23rd November, 1998 executed under Survey Order No. 55/96 and filed in the Lands and Surveys Division;
- (c) having been declared by the President by Order by Legal Notice No. 166 of 2000 as land required for a public purpose and approved for such purpose by the Parliament of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago by Resolution of the Senate on 8th May, 2001 and the House of Representatives on 11th May, 2001, have been acquired for the following purpose: Extension of the Solomon Hochoy Highway.

SCHEDULE

Several parcels of land together containing 40.1062 hectares more or less, situate between the Tarouba Overpass, Tarouba, San Fernando and the Cross Crossing Roundabout, in the Ward of Naparima, in the County of Victoria and further described as follows:

- (a) a parcel of land comprising 85,901 square metres more or less, said to belong now or formerly to Caroni (1975) Limited;
- (b) a parcel of land comprising 593.3 square metres more or less, said to belong now or formerly to Johamiah;
- (c) a parcel of land comprising 714.8 square metres more or less, said to belong now or formerly to Valina Herbert;
- (d) a parcel of land comprising 636.2 square metres more or less, said to belong now or formerly to Carmen Corolla;
