THE LAND ACQUISITION (DECLARATION OF ACQUISITION)
(NO. 13) ORDER, 2001

- Citation 1. This Order may be cited as the Land Acquisition (Declaration of Acquisition) (No. 13) Order, 2001.
- Declaration of acquisition 2. The parcels of land—
- (a) comprising together 1 771.3 square metres more or less, situate at First Street, San Juan, in the Ward of St. Ann's in the County of St. George;
 - (b) described in the Schedule and coloured raw sienna on a plan of survey signed by the Director of Surveys and dated 26th May, 2000 executed under Survey Order No. 101/99 and filed in the Lands and Surveys Division;
 - (c) having been declared by the President by Order by Legal Notice No. 22 of 2001 as land required for a public purpose and approved for such purpose by the Parliament of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago by Resolution of the Senate on 8th May, 2001, and the House of Representatives on 11th May, 2001, have been acquired for the following purposr: Extention of the San Juan Market.

SCHEDULE

The parcels of land together comprising approximately 1 771.3 square metres more or less, situate at First Street, San Juan in the Ward of St. Ann's in the County of St. George and said to belong now or formerly to Aranguez Estates Limited and currently tenanted by Eulaline M. Keen and Aziz Ali.

The land is more particularly shown coloured raw sienna on a Survey Plan filed in Book 1243, Folio 36 in the Vault of the Lands and Surveys Department, Red House, Port-of-Spain.
