NOTICE OF LAND LIKELY TO BE REQUIRED FOR A PUBLIC
PURPOSE

NOTICE is hereby given that it appears to the President that the parcels of land described in the Schedule and situate at Speyside, in the Ward of Tobago in the Parish of St. John are lands likely to be required for a purpose which in the opinion of the President is a public purpose: For Coastal Protection Measures and Conservation of Wetlands.

SCHEDULE

The parcels of land together containing:

- (a) a parcel of land comprising approximately 3,550 square feet more or less, bounded on the north by State land, on the south by the Trois Rivières Estate, on the east by the sea and on the west by the Windward Main Road and said to belong now or formerly to Marianne De Freitas; and
- (b) a parcel of land comprising approximately 4 acres more or less, bounded on the north by a river, on the west by Lucy Vale Road, on the east by the sea and on the south by a Road Reserve to the old recreation ground.

Further particulars of the location and description of the land may be obtained from the Office of the Director of Surveys, 118, Frederick Street, Port-of-Spain.
