NOTICE OF LAND LIKELY TO BE REQUIRED FOR A PUBLIC
PURPOSE

NOTICE is hereby given that it appears to the President that the parcel of land described in the Schedule and situate at Soledad Road, Claxton Bay, in the Ward of Pointe-a-Pierre, in the County of Victoria is land likely to be needed for a purpose which in the opinion of the President is a public purpose: Reconstruction of Mt. Pleasant Government Primary School.

SCHEDULE

A parcel of land comprising 0.8 of an acre more or less, situate at Soledad Road, Claxton Bay, in the Ward of Pointe-a-Pierre, in the County of Victoria bounded on the north and south by lands said to belong now or formerly to Caroni (1975) Limited, on the east by Soledad Road and on the west by lands said to belong now or formerly to Basser Mohammed.
