NOTICE OF LAND LIKELY TO BE REQUIRED FOR A PUBLIC
PURPOSE

NOTICE is hereby given that it appears to the President that the parcels of land described in the Schedule and situate at Cedar Hill Trace, in the Ward of Manzanilla in the County of St. Andrew are land likely to be needed for a purpose which in the opinion of the President is a public purpose: Construction of the Manzanilla Secondary School.

SCHEDULE

The two parcels of land together comprising approximately 7 acres situate at Cedar Hill Trace in the Ward of Manzanilla, in the County of St. Andrew and described hereunder:

- (a) Parcel A said to belong now or formerly to G. Johnson; and
- (b) Parcel B said to belong to the State but leased to O. Black.
