AN ORDINANCE to amend the law as to exemptions from the taxes imposed by the Lands and Buildings Taxes Ordinance, 1920.

[19th May, 1921.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Lands and Buildings Taxes (Amendment) Ordinance, 1921, and shall be construed as one with the Lands and Buildings Taxes Ordinance, 1920, in this Ordinance called the Principal Ordinance. Short title and construction. Ord. 14-1920.

2. There shall be added at the end of sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Principal Ordinance (which exempts certain lands and buildings from the taxes imposed by the Principal Ordinance) the following, namely :— Exemption of Crown lands and buildings.

“(d.) Lands and buildings belonging to and in the occupation of the Crown or its immediate servants for public purposes.”

- Repeal. 3. The words "But save as aforesaid no rates or land taxes shall be paid or chargeable in respect of any house or land belonging to His Majesty the King or occupied for the use of the Colony" in section 3 of the Land Tax Exemption Ordinance are hereby repealed so far as regards the tax imposed by the Principal Ordinance.

- Repeal. 4. The Lands and Buildings Taxes (No. 2) Ordinance, 1920, is hereby repealed.
