AN ORDINANCE to amend the Lands and Buildings  
Taxes Ordinance, Cap. 204.

[8th June, 1932.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Lands and Buildings Taxes (Amendment) Ordinance, 1932, and shall be construed as one with the Lands and Buildings Taxes Ordinance, Cap. 204, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Sub-section (1) of section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting after the word "shall" in the second line of the said section the following—“ (if previously notified by the Warden so to do) ”.

**3.** Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting the words "from the records of his office," after the word "district" in the third line of the said section.

Reduction of

**4.—(1)** The word "ten" shall be substituted for the word "twenty-five" where the latter word occurs in sections 14 (2), 21, 22 (2) and 23 (1) of the Principal Ordinance and in the First and Second Schedules thereto.

Saving.

(2) This section shall not affect taxes which under the Principal Ordinance became due and payable on or before the thirty-first day of March, 1931, and are unpaid at the date of the commencement of this Ordinance.
