AN ORDINANCE to amend the Lands and Buildings Taxes Ordinance, Ch. 33. No. 2.

E NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof. Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Lands and Buildings Taxes (Amendment) Ordinance, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Lands and Buildings Taxes Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Short title

Amendment
of section 3
of Principal
Ordinance.

2. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding thereto the following new subsection immediately after subsection (2) thereof:—

“(3) The Governor in Council may from time to time by order prescribe that in respect of any specified year or years and in respect of any specified area or areas the tax on buildings imposed by this Ordinance shall be at higher rates than those prescribed in subsection (1) of this section; but the Governor in Council shall in no case prescribe a rate which exceeds ten per centum of the annual taxable value of any building liable to such tax.”

Amendment
of section 20
of Principal
Ordinance.

3. Section 20 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting for the words “due any payable”, which appear in the third line of subsection (1) thereof, the words “due and payable”.

Amendment
of section 27
of Principal
Ordinance.

4. Section 27 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding immediately after the words “inserted in the *Royal Gazette*”, which appear in subsection (2) thereof, the words “and posted up in a conspicuous place at his office and sub-offices for a period of one month”.
