AN ORDINANCE to amend the Lands and Buildings Taxes Ordinance, Ch. 33. No. 2.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof. Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Lands and Buildings Taxes (Amendment) Ordinance, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Lands and Buildings Taxes Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Short title

2. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced by the following section:—

5 (1) In wards in which there is a Local Road Board the owner of any land taxable under this Ordinance shall make a return on or before the 31st of October, in each year according to such form as may from time to time be approved by the Governor specifying the name of the occupier, if any, of such land or any part thereof, and of the owner or occupier of every building on such land and the annual value of every such building.

(2) Such return shall be filed in the Warden's office and shall, for the purposes of voting at an election for a Local Road Board, be deemed to be and form part of the assessment roll of the particular ward in which the land or building in respect of which the return is made is situated."

3. Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the words "In the year 1948 and every subsequent fifteenth year" for the words "In the year 1921 and every subsequent third year" appearing therein.

4. Section 12 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) by substituting the word "fourteen" for the word "two" occurring in subsection (1);

(b) by substituting the word "period" for the words "second and third years" occurring in subsection (2).

5. Subsection (1) of section 14 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the word "taxpayer" for the word "taxpaper".

6. Subsection (2) of section 15 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the word "period" for the words "year or two years" appearing therein.
