TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 18 of 1968

AN ACT to amend the Lands and Buildings Taxes
Ordinance, Ch. 33. No. 7.

[Assented to 28th June, 1968]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, **Enactment**
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Lands and Buildings **Short title**
Taxes (Amendment) Act, 1968.

2. The Lands and Buildings Taxes Ordinance is amended by inserting—

(a) in section 2 in its appropriate alphabetical order, the following definitions:

“ “assessment” includes re-assessment; and
“ assess” shall be construed accordingly”;

(b) immediately after subsection (2) of section 12 thereof, the following:—

“(3) The expression “such alterations and additions as may be required to make the same true and correct” in subsection (2) includes the power to make re-assessments of lands and buildings during the period for which such assessment roll continues in operation.”

3. The Lands and Buildings Taxes Ordinance shall have effect and be deemed for all purposes to have had effect as if it had originally been enacted as amended by section 2.
