RULES

MADE BY THE LAND SURVEY BOARD UNDER SECTION 14(2) OF THE
LAND SURVEYORS ORDINANCE

THE LAND SURVEYORS (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1957

Short title.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Land Surveyors (Amendment) Rules, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Land Surveyors Rules, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rules.

Rule 17 of
the Principal
Rules amended.

2. Rule 17 of the Principal Rules is hereby amended by deleting the semicolon and word "or" occurring at the end of the paragraph (b) thereof and substituting therefor a colon and the following proviso :—

"Provided that any such Topographical Assistant who was on the Staff of the Lands and Surveys Department on or before the 21st day of September, 1950—

(a) has, as an alternative to the examinations provided for in Rule 11, passed either of the two examinations to be held in December, 1957 and in December, 1958, in accordance with the Rules which were in force immediately before the 21st day of September, 1950; and

(b) has, on or before the 1st day of September, in the year in which he intends to sit the said examination, given to the Director of Surveys notice in writing of his intention to sit the said examination."
