MADE WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY THE LAND SURVEY BOARD UNDER SECTION 14 (2) OF THE LAND SURVEYORS ORDINANCE

THE LAND SURVEYORS (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1966

1. These Rules may be cited as the Land Surveyors (Amendment) Rules, Citation. 1966.

2. The Land Surveyors Rules set out in the Second Schedule to the Land Surveyors Ordinance are hereby amended:—

(a) in rule 16—

(i) by substituting the words "Commonwealth country" for the words "other part of the British Commonwealth" wherever the latter words occur therein;

(ii) by adding immediately after paragraph (3) thereof the following:

"(4) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraphs (1) to (3) of this Rule, the Governor-General may, on the recommendation of the Board, grant a Pupil Surveyor an exemption not exceeding three years of the period of four years of apprenticeship required by Rule 4."

(b) in subparagraph (a) of paragraph (1) of rule 17, by substituting for the word "examined" in the third line thereof the word "exempted."
