ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 44F(1)
OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(INDEPENDENCE SQUARE) ORDER, 1981

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Independence Square) Order, 1981.
2. This Order shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Monday, 12th January, 1981 and shall cease at 6.00 p.m. on Tuesday, 10th February, 1981. Commence-
ment and
cessation
3. Vehicular traffic shall be restricted to the northern half of Independence Square North between Frederick Street and Henry Street, and to the southern half of Independence Square South between Henry Street and Broadway. Traffic
restriction
4. During the times and on the dates shown in paragraph 2 no person may park or cause or permit any vehicle to be parked or to remain on any of the following roads:— Parking
prohibited
 - (i) Independence Square North between Frederick Street and Henry Street; and
 - (ii) Independence Square South between Charlotte Street and Broadway—on the northern half only.
5. During the times and on the dates shown in paragraph 2 taxis normally using the taxi stand on the northern side of Independence Square South between Henry Street and Broadway shall use the northern half of Independence Square South between Charlotte Street and Henry Street. Temporary
Taxi Stand
6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order, may be removed by the police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with sections 78B and 78c of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance.
