ORDER

MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 44F(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(INDEPENDENCE SQUARE) ORDER, 1980

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Independence Square) Order, 1980. Citation

2. This Order shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Friday, 18th January, 1980, and shall cease at 6.00 a.m. on Friday, 15th February, 1980. Commencement and cessation

3. Vehicular traffic shall be restricted to:— Traffic restricted
(a) the northern half of Independence Square North between Frederick Street and Henry Street; and
(b) the southern half of Independence Square South between Henry Street and Broadway.

4. Subject to paragraph (5), no person may park or cause or permit any vehicle to be parked or to remain on any of the following roads:— Parking prohibited on certain roads
(a) Independence Square North between Frederick Street and Henry Street; and
(b) Independence Square South between Charlotte Street and Broadway—on the northern half only.

5. Taxis normally plying for hire at the taxi stand situated on the northern side of Independence Square South between Henry Street and Broadway may use the northern half of Independence Square South between Charlotte Street and Henry Street as a temporary taxi stand. Temporary taxi stand

6. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order, may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with sections 78B and 78C of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance. Removal and impounding of unlawfully parked vehicles.
