AN ACT respecting the commencement of the National Lotteries Act, 1968, and to provide for indemnity in respect of certain acts or things done under, and to amend, the said Act.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment.
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House
of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the
authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the National Lotteries (Com- Short title.
mencement and Indemnity) Act, 1970.

2. Notwithstanding any rule of law to the contrary, including in particular, section 33 of the National Lotteries Act, 1968 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1968"), the Act of 1968 shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 12th day of August, 1968.

Indemnity.

3. No action or other legal proceedings of any kind whatever whether now pending or not, shall be entertained in respect of or in consequence of any act or thing, done under and in pursuance of the Act of 1968, by reason only that at the material time the Act of 1968 had not yet been proclaimed.
