AN ACT to amend the National Lotteries Act,  
Chap. 21:04

*[Assented to 28th December, 1988]*

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment  
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the National Lotteries Short title  
(Amendment) Act, 1988.

2. The National Lotteries Act is amended—

(a) in section 2 by inserting in alphabetical order the following definitions—

“ “instant lottery” means a national lottery wherein a purchaser of a ticket is able to determine, at the time of purchase, whether or not he is a winner by—

(a) rubbing a coin on a section of the ticket which will reveal six numbered panels; and

(b) verifying that three out of the six panels bear the same numbers;

“instant lottery surplus” means the amount realised after defraying all the expenses and payment of the prize money from the proceeds received from each instant lottery;” and

(b) by inserting immediately after section 23 the following new section—

“Instant  
lottery  
surplus

23A. Notwithstanding anything contained in section 21 or section 23 the instant lottery surplus shall be paid into the Sport and Culture Fund established by section 3 of the Sport and Culture Fund Act, 1988.”.
