THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)  
(NO. 2) ORDER, 2001

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for Admission) (No. 2) Order, 2001.

2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule being a citizen of the United Kingdom qualified to practise law in England and Wales for not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law in Trinidad and Tobago subject to the terms and conditions specified in Part II of the Schedule.

PART I

Michael Jacob Beloff	Of the Honourable Society of the Gray's Inn, Barrister-at-law, admitted to practise at the Bar of England and Wales on the 21st day of November, 1967.

PART II

Mr. Michael Jacob Beloff, Q.C., is eligible to be admitted to practise law as an attorney-at-law in relation to the following cause and any matter, suit or other proceeding arising out of or in connection therewith namely Civil Appeal No. 225 of 1998 Grell-Taurel Limited-*v*-The Caribbean Home Insurance Company Limited and Others.
