THE CHIEF JUSTICE UNDER SECTION 15A OF THE LEGAL
PROFESSION ACT

THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)
(NO. 3) ORDER, 2001

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for Admission) (No. 3) Order, 2001.

2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule being a citizen of the United Kingdom qualified to practise law in England and Wales for not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law in Trinidad and Tobago subject to the terms and conditions specified in Part II of the Schedule.

PART I

Name	Academic Qualification
Timothy Derrick Straker	Of the Honourable Society of the Gray's Inn, Barrister-at-law, admitted to practise at the Bar of England and Wales on the 28th day of July, 1977.

PART II

Mr. Timothy Derrick Straker, Q.C., is eligible to be admitted to practise law as an Attorney-at-law in the High Court and Court of Appeal in relation to the following causes and any matter, suit or other proceedings arising out of or in connection therewith namely:

1. High Court Action No. 3225 of 2000 In the matter of *Princess Smart v. Eulalie James*
2. High Court Action No. 3226 of 2000 In the matter of *Paul Phagoo v. Patrick Manning*
