THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)  
(NO. 4) ORDER, 2001

Citation 1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for  
Admission) (No. 4) Order, 2001.

Eligibility for 2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule being a citizen of  
admission to the United Kingdom qualified to practise law in England and Wales for  
practise not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law in  
Trinidad and Tobago subject to the terms and conditions specified in  
Part II of the Schedule.

## PART I

## PART II

Mr. Elliot Mottley, Q.C., is eligible to be admitted to practise law as an attorney-at-law in relation to the following cause and any matter, suit or other proceeding arising out of or in connection therewith namely HCA No. 2251 of 2000 Caribbean Insurance Company Limited-*v*-Republic Bank Limited.
