THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)
(NO. 8) ORDER, 2001

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for Citation Admission) (No. 8) Order, 2001.

2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule being a citizen of the United Kingdom qualified to practise law in England and Wales for not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law in Trinidad and Tobago subject to the terms and conditions specified in Part II of the Schedule:

PART I

Name	Academic Qualification
Mr. Jonathan Crystal	Of the Honourable Society of the Middle Temple; Barrister-at-law; admitted to practise at the Bar of England and Wales in July, 1972.

PART II

Mr. Jonathan Crystal, is eligible to be admitted to practise law as an Attorney-at-law in the High Court and the Court of Appeal in relation to the following causes and any matter, suit or other proceeding arising out of or in connection with the said matters namely:

- (a) High Court Action No. 1812 of 2000 Lindsay Gillette, Computers and Controls and Open Telecom Limited v. Trinidad Express Newspapers Limited, Ken Gordon, Craig Reynold, Maxie Cuffie and Irene Medina;
- (b) High Court Action No. 556 of 2001 Augustine Logie v. National Broadcasting Network Limited and Ruskin Mark.
