THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION)
(NO. 15) ORDER, 2007

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Profession (Eligibility for Admission) (No. 15) Order, 2007. Citation

2. The person referred to in Part I of the Schedule, being a Commonwealth citizen admitted to practise law in England and Wales for not less than ten years, is eligible to be admitted to practise law in Trinidad and Tobago subject to the terms and conditions specified in Part II of the Schedule. PART I

Mr. John Anthony Tackaberry	Of the Honourable Society of Gray's Inn; Barrister; admitted to practise at the Bar of England and Wales in July, 1967 and appointed Queen's Counsel in 1982.

PART II

Mr. John Anthony Tackaberry, is eligible to be admitted to practise law as an attorney-at-law in relation to the following cause and any matter, suit or other proceedings arising out of or in connection with the said matter, namely:

Claim No. CV. 2007-0224—In the matter of the Arbitration Act, 1939 and Parts 60 and 61 of the Civil Proceedings Rules, 1998 as amended; and between the National Insurance Property Development Company Limited (Claimant) and NH International (Caribbean) Limited (Defendant).
