### A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 71 of the National Insurance Act, 1971, that the said Act shall come into operation on a day or days appointed by the Governor-General by Proclamation published in the *Gazette* and that the Governor-General may appoint different days for different provisions of the Act and in particular for provisions relating to different benefits or descriptions of benefits under the Act or for the application of different provisions of the Act to different categories of persons:

Now, therefore, I, SOLOMON HOCHOY, Governor-General as aforesaid, hereby appoint the 10th April, 1972 to be the day on which the provisions of section 36 to section 43 and section 44(1)(d) and (f) to section 54 of Part III, save in their application to employed persons employed by more than one person within the meaning of the said section 43, and the provisions of section 55 and section 57 to section 61 and section 63 to section 68 of Part IV, of the said Act shall come into operation.
