### A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 71 of the National Insurance Act, 1971, that the said Act shall come into operation on a day or days appointed by the Governor-General by Proclamation published in the *Gazette* and that the Governor-General may appoint different days for different provisions of the Act and in particular for provisions relating to different benefits or descriptions of benefits under the Act or for the application of different provisions of the Act to different categories of persons:

Now, therefore, I, ARTHUR HUGH McSHINE, Acting Governor-General as aforesaid, hereby appoint the 15th January, 1973, to be the day on which the provisions of sections (44)(1) (a), (b) and (c) of the said Act, shall come into operation.
