*Liquor Licences (Amendment).*

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Liquor Licences Ordinance,  
Ch. 32. No. 11.

Commencement.

[31st December, 1942.]

Short title, etc.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Licences (Amendment) Ordinance, 1942, and shall be read and construed as one with the Liquor Licences Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Section 37 of

2. Section 37 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) by substituting the following for paragraph (a) of subsection (1) thereof :—

“ (a) Sufficient notice of such application shall have been given to the officer of Police in charge of the division, who may oppose the same ; and ”

(b) by substituting the words “ the officer of Police in charge of the division in which the entertainment is to be conducted ” for the words “ the Commissioner of Police ” where they occur in subsection (3) thereof ; and

(c) by substituting the words “ such officer of Police ” for the words “ the Commissioner ” where it occurs in subsection (3) thereof.
