ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with  
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Licences  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1947 and shall be read as one with  
the Liquor Licences Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the  
Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 68 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding thereto the following as paragraph (f):—

Amendment  
of section 68  
of Principal  
Ordinance

“(f) on any person selling or offering for sale any intoxicating liquor certified by the Commissioner of Inland Revenue to be unfit for consumption as a beverage and used solely as a flavouring agent: Provided that the same is sold under a trade name and in the original containers as supplied by the manufacturers.”
