AN ACT to amend the Liquor Licences Ordinance, 1955

[Assented to 4th February, 1966]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by
the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Liquor Licences Short title and
(Amendment) Act, 1966. commencement

(2) This Act shall come into operation on the 22nd
day of January, 1966.

2. The Second Schedule to the Liquor Licences Ordinance, 1955, as amended by the Fourth Schedule to the Finance Act, 1963, is hereby amended by deleting the words—

“Special Restaurant Licence ... For Port-of-Spain and within half a mile thereof — \$1,500 per annum.

Special Restaurant Licence ... For San Fernando and within half a mile thereof — \$1,200 per annum.

Special Restaurant Licence ... Elsewhere — \$900 per annum”

occurring therein and by substituting therefor the words—

“Special Restaurant Licence ... For Port-of-Spain and within half a mile thereof — \$1,400 per annum.

Special Restaurant Licence ... For San Fernando and within half a mile thereof — \$1,000 per annum.

Special Restaurant Licence ... Elsewhere — \$600 per annum”
