MADE BY THE PRESIDENT UNDER SECTION 35 OF THE CENTRAL TENDERS
BOARD ORDINANCE

THE CENTRAL TENDERS BOARD (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 1995

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Central Tenders Board Citation
(Amendment) Regulations, 1995.
2. In these Regulations, “the Regulations” means the Central Interpre-

3. Regulation 11 of the Regulations is amended— Regulation 11
amended
 - (a) in subregulation (2)—
 - (i) by deleting the words “Subject to paragraph (3), any” and substituting the word “Any”;
 - (ii) by deleting the words “one hundred thousand dollars” in both places where they occur and substituting in each place the words “five hundred thousand dollars”; and
 - (b) by revoking subregulation (3).
4. Regulation 12 of the Regulations is amended— Regulation 12
amended
 - (a) by deleting the words “County Council” and “County Councils” wherever they occur and substituting respectively in each place the words “Municipal Council” and “Municipal Councils”;
 - (b) by revoking subregulation (1) and substituting the following subregulation:
 - “ (1) A Permanent Secretary or an officer of a statutory body (other than a Municipal Council) appointed for that purpose by such statutory body may act for the Board where the total value of the articles to be supplied or the works and services to be undertaken does not exceed in the case of—
 - (a) a Permanent Secretary, one hundred thousand dollars; or
 - (b) an officer appointed under this subregulation, twenty-five thousand dollars,

but he shall not for the purpose of giving himself authority to act under this regulation sub-divide the quantity of articles to be supplied or works and services to be undertaken into two or more portions so that the value of each portion places such portion within his jurisdiction.”; and

- (c) in subregulation (3), by deleting the words “in either case exceed twenty-five thousand dollars.” and substituting the following words:

“exceed in the case of—

- (a) a Permanent Secretary, one hundred thousand dollars; or
 (b) an officer of a statutory body, twenty-five thousand dollars.”.

5. The Regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 12 the following regulation:

“Purchases of
computer
equipment

12A. Notwithstanding regulations 11 and 12, purchases of main frames, major networks or work stations for computer systems shall be approved by the Minister to whom responsibility for national information systems is assigned.”.
