WAGES AND TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE FOR
ALL WORKERS OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

NOTICE is hereby given that in accordance with the provisions of section 16 of the Minimum Wages Act, Chap. 88:04 the Minister of Labour, Manpower Development and Industrial Relations proposes to make an Order fixing the minimum rate of wages in respect of workers in Trinidad and Tobago. The title of the said Order is the Minimum Wages Order, 2001.

Under the provisions of section 17(1) of the Act a person objecting to the making of an Order shall forward his objection to the Minister stating—

- (a) the grounds of objections;
- (b) the nature of his interest in the matter;
- (c) such additions, modifications or amendments to the draft Order as he may think fit.

Any written objection to the proposed Order shall be submitted not later than 26th November, 2001 addressed to:
