THE HIGHWAYS ACT, 1970

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 3(1) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT, 1970

THE CLASSIFICATION OF HIGHWAYS (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1977

WHEREAS the Classification of Highways Order, 1975 was made in pursuance G.N. No. 51 of section 3(1) of the Highways Act, 1970 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"): of 1975

And whereas the East-West roadway situate between the Eastern Main Road and Fifth Street commencing at the premises of the Public Transport Service Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") at San Juan and ending at the Port-of-Spain Terminal of the Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "Priority Bus Route") is to be brought into use as a special road and the Minister is of the opinion that it should be reserved for use by Public Service Vehicles of the Corporation, Police Service Vehicles marked as such, Fire Service Vehicles and Ambulances and Vehicles used for the repair or maintenance of the priority bus route or of any services supplied by a public utility along the route:

Now, therefore, the Minister in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 3(1) of the Act hereby orders as follows:—

Citation 1. This Order may be cited as the Classification of Highways (Amendment) Order, 1977.

G.N. No. 51 of 1975 amended 2. The Schedule to the Classification of Highways Order, 1975 is amended by inserting immediately after Part I of the Schedule, the following new Part:—

"PART 1A

SPECIAL ROADS—TRINIDAD

Name of Road	County	Ward
Priority Bus Route	... St. George St. Ann's

The above-mentioned road is to be used exclusively by public service vehicles of the Public Transport Service Corporation, Police Service vehicles marked as such, Fire Service vehicles and ambulances and vehicles used for the repair or maintenance of the priority bus route or of any service supplied by a public utility along the route."
