HIGHWAYS ACT, CHAP. 48:01

THE CLASSIFICATION OF HIGHWAYS (SIR SOLOMON HOCHOY
HIGHWAY) ORDER, 1982

1. This Order may be cited as the Classification of Highways (Sir Citation
Solomon Hochoy Highway) Order, 1982.

2. The road known as the Sir Solomon Hochoy Highway and Road
described in the Schedule to this Order is classified under section 3(1) classified
of the Highways Act as a main road.

SCHEDULE

All that strip or parcel of land commencing in the North at the point where the centre lines of the Princess Margaret Highway and the Southern Main Road through Chaguanas (also called the Chaguanas Main Road) intersect each other and continuing in a generally southerly direction with varying widths, and intersecting successively several roads including, Connector Road running East to Carlsen Field, the Couva Main Road running East into Preysal, the Cedar Hill Road and the Guaracara-Tabaquite Road and ending, after traversing a distance of approximately twenty-five (25) kilometres at a point approximately 1.2 kilometres North and 0.9 kilometres East of the Mon Repos round-about situate on the San Fernando By-Pass Road.
