MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 3(1) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT

THE CLASSIFICATION OF HIGHWAYS (PRINCESS MARGARET
HIGHWAY EXTENSION) ORDER, 1984

THIS ORDER may be cited as the Classification of Highways (Princess Margaret Highway Extension) Order, 1984. Citation

2. The road known as the Princess Margaret Highway Extension and described in the Schedule to this Order is classified under section 3(1) of the Highways Act as a main road. Road classified

SCHEDULE

All that strip or parcel of land commencing on the South at the point where the centre lines of the Princess Margaret Highway and the Churchill-Roosevelt Highway intersect and continuing in a generally northerly direction with varying widths of thirty-two metres (32 m) and over and intersecting the Priority Bus Route at Mount Hope and ending in the North at the intersection with the Eastern Main Road after traversing a distance of approximately two and one-tenth kilometres (2.1 km).
