MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 38 OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT

THE BERGORAT TRACE (CLOSURE) ORDER, 2000

1. This Order may be cited as the Bergorat Trace (Closure) Order, Citation 2000.

2. Those portions of Bergorat Trace described in the Schedule hereby cease to be a highway.

SCHEDULE

Those portions of Bergorat Trace situate in the Ward of Guayaguayare, in the County of Mayaro, shown on Cadastral Street H.5.I.; 56E/2/d, together comprising six parcels of land totalling approximately 0.3438 hectare and bounded on the north by lands belonging now or formerly to Milan Mischier and the Trinidad and Tobago Police Association, on the east by the Sea, on the south by lands belonging now or formerly to Milan Mischier and Olga Richardson and on the west by the Mayaro-Guayaguayare Road. The parcels are more particularly described in the Survey Order No. 80/1996 and shown on Plan J.B. 245 and lodged in the Vault of the Lands and Surveys Division.
