AN ORDINANCE to amend the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance, Ch. 16. No. 3.

**E**NACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title

Construction.  
Ch. 16 No. 3.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1946 and shall be read as one with the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 28 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding thereto the following subsection (5):—

“(5) It shall be lawful for any person subject to the orders of the Military Authority to drive a motor vehicle owned or hired by the Military Authority whilst such vehicle is being used for military purposes so long as he is the holder of an identification card in a form approved by the Licensing Authority and signed by the Commander, South Caribbean Area or by a military officer authorised by him in that behalf provided that such person is not disqualified by law from holding a driving permit under the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance and is on duty and is driving a vehicle of the class specified in the identification card.
