TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO  
**Act No. 36 of 1967**

AN ACT to amend the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic  
Ordinance, Ch. 16. No. 3.

*[Assented to 12th December, 1967]*

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, <sup>Enactment</sup>  
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and  
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and  
by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and <sup>Short title.</sup>  
Road Traffic (Amendment) Act, 1967.

2. The Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance is amended—

(a) by substituting for the definition of “rented car” occurring in section 2 the following definition :—

“ “rented car” means a motor vehicle, other than a motor cycle, of a type approved by the Licensing Authority and having seating accommodation for not more than eight persons including the driver, which is privately hired from the owner and which is not to be used as a public service vehicle;”;

(b) by inserting the words “or a rented motor cycle” immediately after the words “rented car” wherever the words “rented car” occur in subsection (2) of section 26;

(c) by inserting immediately after paragraph (5A) of the First Schedule (as contained in Part 2 of the Provisional Collection of Taxes (General Variation) Order, 1963) the following paragraph :—

*Fees and Duties*

“(5B) Rented motor cycle ... 12.00”
