## THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, CH. 16, No. 3

MADE BY THE TRANSPORT BOARD UNDER SECTION 44(2) OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, AS ENACTED BY THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1956.

## THE SPECIAL SPEED LIMITS ORDER, 1979

1. This Order may be cited as the Special Speed Limits Order, 1979.
2. The special speed limits specified in the fourth column of the First Schedule are hereby imposed with respect to the roads specified in the first column of the said Schedule in relation to the classes or descriptions of motor vehicles specified in the second column and during the periods specified in the third column of the said Schedule.
3. The Orders mentioned in the Second Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked.
