ORDER

MADE BY THE TRANSPORT BOARD UNDER SECTION 44C OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, AS ENACTED BY THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1956

THE GOODS VEHICLES STANDS PARKING ORDER, 1979

1. This Order may be cited as the Goods Vehicles Stands Parking Order, 1979.

2. The goods vehicles stands described in the Schedule are hereby appointed as places where goods vehicles may be parked.

3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a goods vehicle to be or to remain parked in the Goods Vehicle Stands appearing in the Schedule.

4. Any person who contravenes the provision of this Order is liable on summary conviction to a fine of one hundred dollars or to imprisonment for three months.

5. The Goods Vehicles Stands Parking Order, 1972 is hereby G.N. 90/1972 revoked.

SCHEDULE

Goods Vehicle Stands—Port-of-Spain

1. The northern side of that portion of South Quay between Charlotte Street and George Street.

Goods Vehicle Stands—Scarborough, Tobago

1. Milford Road, on the southern side, from a point thirty-five feet West of Wilson Road and extending in a westerly direction for three hundred feet. All goods vehicles facing north-east.
