ORDER

MADE BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL UNDER SUBSECTION (2) OF SECTION 78A OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, AS ENACTED BY THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1963

THE RESTRICTION OF PARKING (PUBLIC BUILDINGS)
ORDER, 1963

1. This Order may be cited as the Restriction of Parking (Public Buildings) Order, 1963.

2. For the purposes of this Order the public buildings described in the first column of the Schedule shall be under the control of the respective public officers mentioned in the second column of the Schedule.

3. The public officers referred to in the second column of the Schedule are hereby authorised to grant permission to any person to park a vehicle in or on any grounds or open space adjoining or attached to the respective public buildings referred to in the first column of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

All buildings occupied as offices by officers of the respective Ministries (except the Red House, the Old Fire Brigade Building and Knowsley)	The Permanent Secretaries of the appropriate Ministries
The Red House and the Old Fire Brigade Building	The Legal Secretary to the Attorney General
Knowsley	The Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Health and Housing
The Magistrates' Courts, Port-of-Spain	The Chief Magistrate
Magistrates' Courts (other than Port-of-Spain)	The Senior Magistrate of the District in which the Court is situate
The Supreme Court, San Fernando	The Sub-Registrar and Deputy Marshal, San Fernando
