THE TRAFFIC SIGNS AND PEDESTRIAN CROSSING
(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2001

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Signs and Pedestrian Crossing (Amendment) Order, 2001. Citation

2. In this Order, "Order" means "the Traffic Signs and Pedestrian Crossing Order, 1992". Interpre-

3. The Order is amended in clause 4 by deleting subclause (j). Clause 4
amended

4. The Order is amended in clause 5— Clause 5
amended

(a) in subclause 2 by deleting the word "whall" and substituting the word "shall":

(b) in subclause 3(a) by—

(i) deleting the word "figure" and substituting the word "icon"; and

(ii) by inserting after the word "light" the words "or by a flashing light."; and

(c) in subclause 3(b) by—

(i) deleting the word "figure" and substituting the word "icon"; and

(ii) deleting all the words commencing with the words "or by a flashing light".

5. The Order is amended in clause 6 (3)(a) by inserting after the words "extending from" in the second place it occurs, the word "the". Clause 6
amended

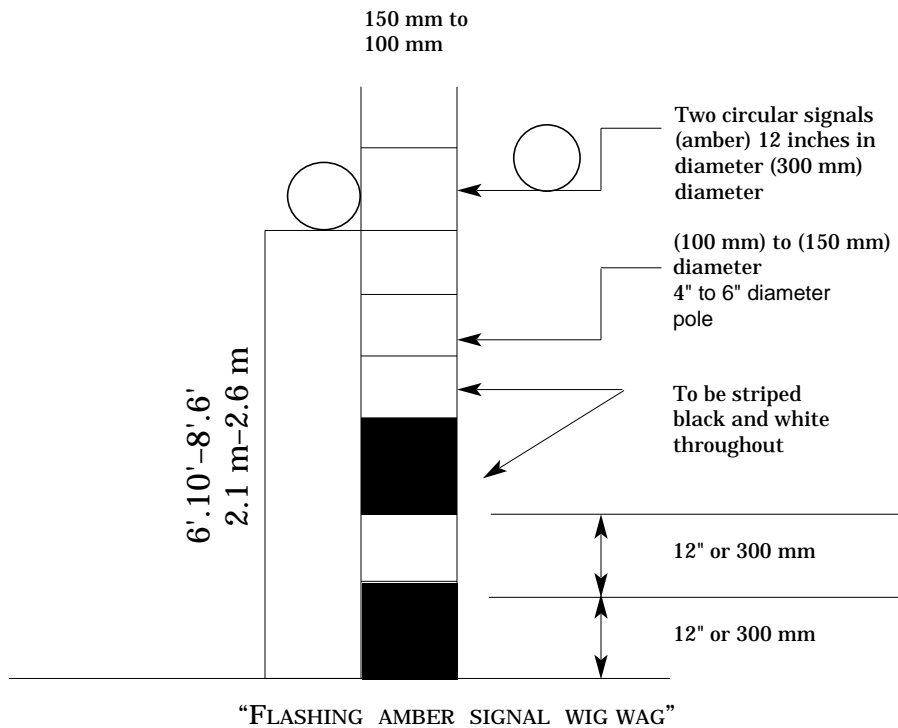
6. The Order is amended in clause 11 by deleting the words "these Regulations" and substituting the words "this Order". Clause 11
amended

- Clause 13 amended 7. The Order is amended in clause 13 by inserting after subclause (3) the following new subclause:
 “ (3) Each mark contained in a give-way line or in a zig zag line may be illuminated by use of a reflecting material.”
- Clause 15 repealed 8. The Order is amended by repealing clause 15.
- Clause 16 inserted 9. The Order is amended by inserting after clause 16 the following new clause:
 “Traffic Sign (Wig Wags) 16A. (1) The traffic signs which may be placed at or near a crossing for the purpose set out in clause 16 may also consist of Wig Wags as indicated in Diagram 8 of the Schedule.
 (2) Wig Wags shall be—
 (a) 300 mm in diameter; and
 (b) so mounted on posts at an average height of 2.5 m above the surface of the ground in the immediate vicinity of the crossing.
 (3) The container which houses the apparatus for illumination of a Wig Wag shall be yellow or black in colour.
 (4) Wig Wags shall be illuminated by a flashing amber signal.
 (5) Each post upon which a Wig Wag is mounted shall be coloured black and white in alternative horizontal bands, and shall be placed in such a position as to be clearly visible to approaching traffic.
 (6) Each band shall be 300 mm in width and shall not be marked on any container which encloses the apparatus for providing the illumination of a Wig Wag.”
- Clause 19 amended 10. The Order is amended in clause 19 by deleting subclauses (2), (3) and (4) and substituting the following:
 “ (2) Every pedestrian on a “Zebra” crossing has precedence over any vehicle and the driver of the vehicle shall accord such precedence to the pedestrian where the pedestrian came onto the “Zebra” crossing prior to the vehicle.”
- Schedule amended 11. The Order is amended in the Schedule—
 (a) in Diagram 1 in the diagram entitled “Pedestrian Signal” by deleting the words “figure standing” and “figure walking” and substituting the word “icon” and “icon” respectively;

- (b) in Diagram 6 entitled “Zebra-Crossings-Road Markings (Single Carriageway) 2 Directional Traffic” by deleting the words “Globe (if necessary)” and substituting the words “Flashing Amber Signals, Globe or Danger Warning Sign.”; and
- (c) by inserting after Diagram 7 entitled “Zebra Crossing Street Furniture” the following new diagram:

“ZEBRA CROSSING STREET FURNITURE—WIG WAG”
