THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, CHAP. 48:50

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND INFRASTRUCTURE UNDER SECTION 65 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL ORDER, 1988

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Control Order, 1988. Citation
- 2. This Order comes into effect on Friday, 4th November, 1988. Commencement

PART I

AROUCA

- 3. Vehicular traffic shall not stop or wait— No stopping or waiting
  - (a) along Range Road, between the Eastern Main Road and a point 75 metres North;
  - (b) along the Eastern Main Road, within 100 metres in either direction of the intersection of the Priority Bus Route and the Eastern Main Road at Five Rivers, Arouca, except at designated locations.
- 4. Vehicular traffic shall proceed— One-way traffic
  - (a) in a northerly direction only along the western extension of Range Road, between the Eastern Main Road and First Street;
  - (b) in a southerly direction only along the eastern extension of Range Road, between the Eastern Main Road and First Street.
- 5. Parking is prohibited on First Street, between Range Road and a point 200 metres East. Parking prohibited

PART II

CHAGUANAS

- 6. Vehicular traffic shall proceed— One-way traffic
  - (a) in a southerly direction only on St. Yves Street;
  - (b) in a southerly direction only on Market Street, between Eleanor Street and Chaguanas Main Road.

Two-way traffic

7. Vehicular traffic may proceed in both directions on Marie Street.

Left turn only

8. Vehicular traffic proceeding—

- (a) South on St. Yves Street shall turn East into Rudranath Capildeo Street;
- (b) North on Marie Street shall turn West into Chaguanas Main Road.

Parking prohibited

9. Parking is prohibited on—

- (a) Marie Street, except for taxis in the taxi stand;
- (b) the Southern Main Road, between Ramsarran Street and Chaguanas Main Road, except for maxi-taxis in the maxi-taxi stands;
- (c) the eastern side of St. Yves Street;
- (d) Rudranath Capildeo Street, between Chaguanas Main Road and Max Murphy Street;
- (e) Max Murphy Street, between Imam Shah Street and Rudranath Capildeo Street;
- (f) Imam Shah Street, between Max Murphy Street and Rene Street;
- (g) Max Street, between Eleanor Street and Chaguanas Main Road;
- (h) the southern side of the Chaguanas Main Road from a point 10 metres East of the Southern Main Road and extending eastwards for a distance of 120 metres;
- (i) Rene Street, between Caroni Savannah Road and Imam Shah Street;
- (j) Market Street, between Chaguanas Main Road and Eleanor Street;
- (k) all slip roads to the Uriah Butler Highway and the Sir Solomon Hochoy Highway;
- (l) the Southern Main Road, between Desmond Street and Allister Street.

Taxi and maxi-taxi stands

10. Taxis and maxi-taxis may park as follows—

- (a) a maximum of seven maxi-taxis facing North on the western side of the Southern Main Road, South of Eleanor Street;
- (b) a maximum of seven taxis facing North on the north-western side of Mid Centre Mall;
- (c) a maximum of eight taxis facing North on the eastern side of Marie Street from the Chaguanas Main Road and extending southwards;
- (d) a maximum of twelve taxis facing East on the northern side of Eleanor Street from the Southern Main Road and extending westwards;
- (e) a maximum of five taxis facing South on the western side of St. Yves Street from Yard Street and extending northwards;
- (f) a maximum of thirty taxis facing North on the north-western side of Mid Centre Mall Car Park;
- (g) a maximum of five taxis facing North on the western side of De Verteuil Street from Chaguanas Main Road and extending northwards.

11. Motorists proceeding in either direction along Chaguanas Main Road may not make a "U" turn at the intersections with the slip roads to the Uriah Butler Highway. No "U" turn

12. The following roads are deemed major roads— Major roads

- (a) John Street, at its intersection with La Clave Street and Lange Street;
- (b) La Clave Street, at its intersection with Penco Street.

### PART III

#### PRINCES TOWN

13. Vehicular traffic shall proceed— One-way traffic

- (a) in an easterly direction only on Cacique Street;
- (b) in an easterly direction only on Waterlane Street;
- (c) in an easterly direction only on Tramline Street;
- (d) in an easterly direction only on St. James Street, between Aldana Street and a point 50 metres East;
- (e) in a westerly direction only on Theodore Street;
- (f) in a northerly direction only on Charlotte Street;
- (g) in a southerly direction only on Buen Intento Road, between Cacique Street and Naparima-Mayaro Road;
- (h) in a southerly direction only on Bonanza Street;
- (i) in a southerly direction only on Railway Road;
- (j) in a southerly direction only on Aldana Street.

14. Vehicular traffic shall proceed in both directions on Armour Street. Two-way traffic

15. Vehicular traffic proceeding on— No right turn

- (a) Buen Intento Road shall not turn right into Naparima-Mayaro Road;
- (b) Railway Road shall not turn right into Naparima-Mayaro Road

16. Vehicular traffic shall not make a "U" turn at the intersection of— No "U" turn

- (a) Naparima-Mayaro Road and Cacique Street;
- (b) Naparima-Mayaro Road and Tramline Street.

17. Parking is prohibited on— Parking prohibited

- (a) Buen Intento Road, between Theodore Street and Naparima-Mayaro Road;
- (b) the southern side of Waterlane Street;
- (c) King Street, between Waterlane Street and Naparima-Mayaro Road;
- (d) the western side of King Street, between Waterlane Street and Theodore Street;

- (e) Lothians Road, between Armour Street and Naparima-Mayaro Road;
- (f) Aldana Street, between the Naparima-Mayaro Road and a point 200 metres South;
- (g) Bonanza Street between the Naparima-Mayaro Road and a point 200 metres South;
- (h) Tramline Street;
- (i) Railway Road from Naparima-Mayaro Road to Tramline Street;
- (j) Cacique Street;
- (k) the western side of Charlotte Street;
- (l) Armour Street between Lothians Road and Aldana Street;
- (m) Naparima-Mayaro Road;
- (n) the eastern side of Aldana Street;
- (o) the eastern side of Bonanza Street;
- (p) the northern side of Armour Street.

Taxi and  
maxi-taxi  
stands

18. Taxis and maxi-taxis may park as follows:

- (a) a maximum of twelve taxis facing South on the western side of Railway Road;
- (b) a maximum of forty-five taxis facing East in the triangular area enclosed by Cacique Street, Buen Intento Road and Naparima-Mayaro Road;
- (c) a maximum of twelve maxi-taxis facing East on the northern side of Naparima-Mayaro Road, East of Buen Intento Road;
- (d) a maximum of twelve maxi-taxis facing East on the southern side of Tramline Street.

PART IV

SIPARIA

One-way  
traffic

19. Vehicular traffic shall proceed—

- (a) in a westerly direction only on George Street between Allies Street and La Pastora Road;
- (b) in an easterly direction only on Mary Street between Allies Street and La Pastora Road;
- (c) in a northerly direction only on Albert Street between Mary Street and Siparia-Erin Road;
- (d) in a northerly direction only on Coora Road Extension, between High Street and De Gannes Street.

Parking  
prohibited

20. Parking is prohibited on—

- (a) Coora Road between High Street and Mary Street;
- (b) La Pastora Road between High Street and George Street.

Parking  
restricted

21. Motorists may park their vehicles on the western side of La Pastora Road between George Street and Mary Street and on the southern side only of George Street between Allies Street and La Pastora Road.

22. Taxis may park as follows—

Taxi stands

- (a) a maximum of six taxis facing North on the western side of Albert Street from Siparia-Erin Road and extending southwards;
- (b) a maximum of ten taxis facing West on the southern side of George Street from Coora Road and extending eastwards.

## PART V

### PENAL

23. Parking is prohibited on—

Parking prohibited

- (a) Clarke Street between San Fernando-Siparia-Erin Road and Penal Rock Road, except for taxis in the taxi stand;
- (b) Ramlal Street, except for taxis in the taxi stands.

24. Except for taxis and maxi-taxis in the taxi/maxi-taxi stands, motorists may park their vehicles on the western side only of San Fernando-Siparia-Erin Road between Dookie Street South and the southern side of the market.

Parking restricted

25. Taxis and maxi-taxis may park as follows—

Taxi and maxi-taxi stands

- (a) a maximum of thirteen taxis on the southern side of Penal Rock Road from a point 12 metres East of San Fernando-Siparia-Erin Road and extending eastwards;
- (b) a maximum of six taxis facing South on the western side of Clarke Street between San Fernando-Siparia-Erin Road and Penal Rock Road;
- (c) a maximum of six taxis facing North on the western side of San Fernando-Siparia-Erin Road from a point ten (10) metres North of Penal Rock Road and extending northwards;
- (d) a maximum of four taxis facing West on the southern side of Ramlal Street;
- (e) a maximum of four maxi-taxis facing North on the western side of San Fernando-Siparia-Erin Road from a point five metres South of the median of the Police Station and extending southwards.

## PART VI

### RIO CLARO

26. Parking is prohibited on De Verteuil Street between Naparima-Mayaro Road and the Fire Station entrance.

Parking prohibited

27. Taxis and maxi-taxis may park as follows—

Taxi and maxi-taxi stands

- (a) a maximum of eight taxis facing East on the northern side of Naparima-Mayaro Road from a point ten (10) metres East of Tabaquite-Rio Claro Road;
- (b) a maximum of five taxis and one maxi-taxi facing North on the western side of Tabaquite-Rio Claro Road from a point twelve (12) metres North of Naparima-Mayaro Road;

- (c) a maximum of fifteen maxi-taxis in the paved area situated at the south-western corner of Naparima-Mayaro Road and De Verteuil Street;
- (d) a maximum of fourteen taxis in the paved area situated at the south-western corner of Naparima-Mayaro Road and De Verteuil Street.

## PART VII

## MAYARO

Taxi and  
maxi-taxi  
stands

## 28. Taxis and maxi-taxi may park as follows—

- (a) a maximum of seven taxis facing West on the southern side of Naparima-Mayaro Road from a point ten (10) metres from Mayaro-Guayaguayare Road and extending westwards;
- (b) a maximum of ten maxi-taxis in the paved area situated at the south-eastern corner of Naparima-Mayaro Road and Mayaro-Guayaguayare Road;
- (c) a maximum of ten taxis in the paved area situated at the south-eastern corner of the Naparima-Mayaro Road and Mayaro-Guayaguayare Road;
- (d) a maximum of five taxis facing South on the eastern side of Peter Hill Road from Naparima-Mayaro Road and extending northwards.

## PART VIII

## GENERAL

Offence

29. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Order is liable on summary conviction to a fine of five hundred dollars or imprisonment for three months.

30. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
