MADE BY THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND INFRASTRUCTURE UNDER SECTION 65
OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (SAN FERNANDO) ORDER, 1988

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Control (San Fernando) Order, Citation 1988.
2. This Order comes into effect on Friday, 4th November, 1988 Commence-
ment
3. Parking is prohibited on— Parking
prohibited
 - (a) Naparima-Mayaro Road between Circular Road and the San Fernando Bye-Pass;
 - (b) St. Joseph Road;
 - (c) Circular Road between Cane Street and a point 200 metres East of London Street;
 - (d) Pointe-a-Pierre Road between Short Street and a point 50 metres North of Cane Street;
 - (e) Royal Road between Circular Road and Navet Road;
 - (f) Navet Road between Royal Road and Skinner Street;
 - (g) La Coulee Street;
 - (h) Rushworth Street between Prince Alfred Street and Gooding Street, between Independence Avenue and Harris Street, and between Bertrand Street and San Fernando Bye-Pass;
 - (i) Independence Avenue;
 - (j) the southern side of La Pique Road between Pointe-a-Pierre Road and a point 50 metres East;
 - (k) the northern side of La Pique Road;
 - (l) Rienzi-Kirton Highway;
 - (m) Keate Street between Independence Avenue and Irving Street;
 - (n) San Fernando Street between Victoria Street and Pointe-a-Pierre Road;
 - (o) Sutton Street between Independence Avenue and Lewis Street;
 - (p) Mon Chagrin Street between North Road and St. Vincent Street;
 - (q) Coffee Street between Medine Street and La Coulee Street, and between La Pique Road and Carib Street;

- (r) the northern side of Coffee Street between Royal Road and Carib Street, during the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays;
- (s) the western side of Mucurapo Street between Lord Street and a point 40 metres South;
- (t) Lord Street between Paradise Street and Mucurapo Street;
- (u) the southern side of High Street between Penitence Street and Chancery Lane.
- (v) Prince-of-Wales Street between Coffee Street and Roy Joseph Street.

**Parking
restricted**

4. Motorists may park their vehicles on—

- (a) the southern side of Circular Road between a point 15 metres East of Pointe-a-Pierre Road and a point 15 metres West of Cane Street;
- (b) the northern side of Cane Street;
- (c) the eastern side of Mon Repos Street;
- (d) the southern side of Coffee Street between Royal Road and Carib Street;
- (e) the southern side of St. James Street between Pointe-a-Pierre Road and Penitence Street;
- (f) the western side of Todd Street between Farah Street and a point 50 metres North of Rienzi-Kirton Highway;
- (g) the southern side of Rushworth Street between Gooding Street and Bertrand Street;
- (h) the southern side of Harris Promenade North, save that only taxis and maxi-taxis may park in the taxi/maxi-taxi stands;
- (i) the northern side of Harris Promenade South;
- (j) the northern side of Crichlow Street between Ciperio Street and a point 50 metres East;
- (k) the southern side of Crichlow Street between a point 80 metres from Ciperio Street and Blanche-Fraser Street;
- (l) the western side of Bertrand Street;
- (m) the eastern side of Blanche-Fraser Street;
- (n) the western side of Mon Chagrin Street between High Street and St. Vincent Street;
- (o) the northern side of Keate Street between Irving Street and Prince-of-Wales Street;
- (p) the western side of Drayton Street;
- (q) the southern side of St. James Street between Penitence Street and a point 30 metres East of Quenca Street, during the hours of 9.30 a.m. to 2.00 p.m.;
- (r) the northern side of High Street between Short Street and Chancery Lane, during the hours of 9.30 a.m. to 2.00 p.m., save that only taxis may park in the taxi stands and in areas designated as no parking zones;

- (s) the southern side of High Street between Mon Chagrin Street and a point 25 metres North of Penitence Street, during the hours of 9.30 a.m. to 2.00 p.m.
- (t) the northern side of Carib Street between La Coulee Street and a point 30 metres East of Coffee Street;
- (u) the southern side of Johnstone Street between Mucurapo Street and a point 40 metres East of Mucurapo Street.

5. Motorists shall proceed—

One-way traffic

- (a) in a southerly direction only on the San Fernando Bye-Pass between Scott Street and Union Hall Roundabout;
- (b) in a northerly direction only on Ciperio Street between Rienzi-Kirton Highway and Scott Street;
- (c) in a northerly direction only on Torrance Street between Stewart Street and Naparima-Mayaro Road;
- (d) in a westerly direction only on St. Joseph Road between London Street and Vernon Joseph Street;
- (e) in a westerly direction only on Circular Road between Pointe-a-Pierre Road and Cane Street;
- (f) in an easterly direction only on Cane Street;
- (g) in a southerly direction only on Royal Road between Coffee Street and Kelshall Street;
- (h) in a northerly direction only on La Coulee Street;
- (i) in a westerly direction only on Crichlow Street;
- (j) in a southerly direction only on London Street between St. Joseph Road and Circular Road;
- (k) in an easterly direction only on Alice Street; and
- (l) in a westerly direction only on Bobb Street.

6. Motorists proceeding—

No "U" turn

- (a) in either direction along Chancery Lane, Independence Avenue and Rienzi-Kirton Highway shall not make a "U" turn at their intersections with Harris Promenade, Keate Street, Sutton Street, Rushworth Street, Ruth Avenue, Todd Street and Ciperio Street;
- (b) North on Mucurapo Street shall not make a "U" turn into Coffee Street.

7. Motorists proceeding—

No right turn

- (a) West on Circular Road shall not make a right turn into London Street;
- (b) South on Coffee Street shall not make a right turn into Johnstone Street;
- (c) West on Old Pleasantville Road shall not make a right turn into the San Fernando Bye-Pass;
- (d) East on Navet Road shall not make a right turn into the San Fernando Bye-Pass;

- (e) North on the San Fernando Bye-Pass shall not make a right turn into Old Pleasantville Road;
- (f) South on the San Fernando Bye-Pass shall not make a right turn into Navet Road;
- (g) North on Mucurapo Street shall not make a right turn into La Pique Road.

No left turn 8. Motorists proceeding South on Hollis Street shall not make a left turn into San Fernando Street.

- Major roads** 9. The following are deemed major roads—
- (a) Circular Road, at its intersection with Cane Street;
 - (b) Royal Road, at its intersection with Navet Road;
 - (c) Gulf City Link Road, at its intersection with Riverside Drive;
 - (d) San Fernando-Siparia-Erin Road at its intersection with the Southern Main Road at Duncan Village;
 - (e) Carib Street at its intersections with Marryat Street and Upper Hillside Street;
 - (f) Phillipine Road at its intersection with Dumfries Road West at Palmiste Estate;
 - (g) Mucurapo Street at its intersection with Keate Street.

- Parking for taxis** 10. Taxis and maxi-taxis may park as follows—
- (a) a maximum of seven taxis on the northern side of High Street from Short Street and extending eastwards;
 - (b) a maximum of forty taxis on the southern side of High Street from a point 10 metres West of Harris Promenade and extending westwards;
 - (c) a maximum of forty taxis in the Borough's car park on Chancery Lane;
 - (d) a maximum of three taxis facing North on the eastern side of Library Street from Harris Promenade and extending southwards;
 - (e) a maximum of four taxis facing West on the southern side of Harris Promenade North from a point 9 metres East of Library Street and extending eastwards;
 - (f) a maximum of fourteen taxis on the northern side of Library Street;
 - (g) a maximum of twelve taxis in the car park enclosed by Harris Promenade North, the Borough's toilets and Library Street;
 - (h) a maximum of twenty-four taxis facing East on the northern side of Coffee Street from just East of the Presentation College exit and extending westwards;
 - (i) a maximum of twelve maxi-taxis on the southern side of Harris Promenade North from a point 9 metres West of Penitence Street and extending eastwards;

- (j) a maximum of six maxi-taxis facing East on the southern side of St. Andrew Street, West of High Street;
- (k) a maximum of sixteen taxis facing South on the western side of Mucurapo Street and extending northwards;
- (l) a maximum of eight taxis facing East on Lord Street from Mucurapo Street and extending westwards.

11. Motorists proceeding North on Balisier Avenue shall turn left at the **Left turn** intersection with Link Road, Pleasantville.

12. Vehicles exceeding 3 tonnes laden weight are not permitted to use the following roads— **Load limitations**

- (a) San Fernando Street between Victoria Street and Pointe-a-Pierre Road;
- (b) McLelland Street;
- (c) Vernon Joseph Street.

13. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Order is liable on summary conviction to a fine of five hundred dollars or imprisonment for three months. **Offence**

14. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. **Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked**
