MADE BY THE MINISTER OF WORKS, INFRASTRUCTURE AND DECENTRALISATION
UNDER SECTION 65 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL ORDER, 1989

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Control Order, 1989.
2. This Order comes into effect on Saturday, 1st April, 1989.

Commencement

PART I

SAN JUAN

3. Motorists shall proceed—

One-way traffic

- (a) in a northerly direction only on the Saddle Road between the Eastern Main Road and Real Street between the hours of 3.00 p.m. and 8.00 p.m. from Mondays to Fridays;
- (b) in a northerly direction only on the Saddle Road between Real Street and Mission Road between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. and 8.00 p.m. from Mondays to Fridays and between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. on Saturdays;
- (c) in a westerly direction only on Mission Road between the Saddle Road and Newallovile Avenue between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. and 8.00 p.m. from Mondays to Fridays and between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. on Saturdays;
- (d) in an easterly direction only on Spencer Road between the Saddle Road and Newallovile Avenue between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. and 8.00 p.m. from Mondays to Fridays and between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. on Saturdays;
- (e) in an easterly direction only on Back Chain Street between El Socorro Road and the Aranguez Main Road;
- (f) in a northerly direction only on Real Street between the Saddle Road and the Santa Cruz Old Road between the hours of 3.00 p.m. and 8.00 p.m. from Mondays to Fridays;
- (g) in an easterly direction only on Bissessar Street between El Socorro Road and Don Miguel Road;
- (h) in a westerly direction only on Maraj Street between El Socorro Road and Don Miguel Road.

4. Parking is prohibited on—

Parking prohibited

- (a) Back Chain Street between El Socorro Road and the Aranguez Main Road between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 8.00 p.m.;
- (b) Spencer Road between the Saddle Road and Newallovile Avenue between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 8.00 p.m.;

- (c) Ryan Street between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. and 8.00 p.m. from Mondays to Fridays;
- (d) the southern side of Maraj Street between El Socorro Road and Don Miguel Road.

No parking,
stopping or
waiting

5. Motorists shall not stop or wait on Mission Road between the Saddle Road and a point forty metres West of the Saddle Road.

PART II

TUNAPUNA

One-way
traffic

6. Between the hours of 5.00 a.m. and 10.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. and 7.00 p.m. from Mondays to Fridays, motorists shall proceed—

- (a) in a westerly direction only on Wilkinson Street between Back Street and Clementy Street;
- (b) in a westerly direction only on Goya Road between the Eastern Main Road and Mohammed Street;
- (c) in a northerly direction only on Goya Road between the Eastern Main Road and Mohammed Street;
- (d) in an easterly direction only on Wilkinson Street between Clementy Street and Goviah Street;
- (e) in a southerly direction only on Ranjit Street between the Eastern Main Road and Wilkinson Street.

No right
turn

7. Motorists proceeding West along the Eastern Main Road shall not turn right between the hours of 5.00 a.m. and 10.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. and 7.00 p.m. from Mondays to Fridays into—

- (a) Caura Road;
- (b) Goya Road.

PART III

GENERAL

Offence

8. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Order is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of five hundred dollars or to imprisonment for three months.

Removal and
impounding
of vehicles

9. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
