ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF WORKS, INFRASTRUCTURE AND DECENTRALIZATION  
UNDER SECTION 65 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (NO. 3) ORDER, 1989

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Control (No. 3) Order, 1989. Citation

PART I—MALABAR

2. The Industrial Estate Road, Malabar Phase III, is deemed the Major Road at all intersections, except at O'Meara Road and Malabar Road.

PART II—SAN RAFAEL

3. Motorists shall proceed in a westerly direction only on Caroni Road from its intersection with the Cumuto-Tumpuna Road for a distance of thirty-five metres. One-way traffic

4. Motorists proceeding South on Tumpuna Road shall not turn right into Arena Road. No right turn

5. Motorists proceeding North on Tumpuna Road from the Cumuto-Tumpuna Road shall not turn left into Arena Road. No left turn

PART III—GENERAL

6. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Order is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of five hundred dollars or to imprisonment for three months. Offence

7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. Removal and impounding of vehicles
