Taxis and maxi-taxis plying for hire shall stand as follows :</p> <p>(a) Sangre Grande route—a maximum of seven maxi-taxis facing south on the eastern side of Raglan Street between Broadway and Sorzano Street ;</p> <p>(b) San Raphael, Brazil and Talparo routes—</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;">(i) a maximum of ten taxis facing west on the northern side of Farfan Street between Queen Street and Cocorite Street ; and</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;">(ii) a maximum of five maxi-taxis facing west on the southern side of Farfan Street between Woodford Street and Queen Street ;</p> <p>(c) Caparo and O'Meara Road routes—a maximum of eight taxis facing east on the northern side of Devenish Street from a point thirty metres East of Queen Street ;</p> <p>(d) Caparo route—a maximum of four maxi-taxis at the north-eastern section of the Princess Royal car park ;</p> <p>(e) Mausica and La Florissante routes—a maximum of eleven taxis facing south on the western side of St. Joseph Street from a point approximately twenty metres north of Hollis Avenue to Rose Street ;</p> <p>(f) Mount Pleasant route—a maximum of six taxis facing north on the western side of Prince Street between Sorzano Street and Broadway ;</p> |

- (g) Sangre Grande, Valencia and Cumuto routes—a maximum of fifteen taxis facing east on the northern side of Broadway between Prince Street and Queen Street;

#### GENERAL

6. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Order is liable on summary conviction to a fine of five hundred dollars or to imprisonment for three months. Offence

Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
