ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF WORKS, INFRASTRUCTURE AND DECENTRALIZATION
UNDER SECTION 65 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL ORDER, 1991

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Control Order, 1991. Citation

PART I

PORT-OF-SPAIN

2. Parking is prohibited on— Parking prohibited
- (a) St. Vincent Street, between Treasury Street and Independence Square North;
 - (b) St. Vincent Street, between Duke Street and Knox Street, on the eastern side;
 - (c) Abercromby Street, between Park Street and New Street, on the eastern side from 6.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.;
 - (d) Abbatoir Road, from the Beetham Highway to a point one hundred metres East of the most easterly of the over-passes over Abbatoir Road, the Priority Bus Route and the Eastern Main Road.
3. Stopping, waiting or parking is prohibited on— Stopping, waiting, parking prohibited
- (a) South Quay, on the southern side, from a point one hundred metres East of Piccadilly Street, to a point twenty-five metres West of Piccadilly Street;
 - (b) Independence Square South, on the northern side, between Chacon Street and Cipriani Circle;
 - (c) Beetham Highway, on the northern side, between Broadway and a point one hundred metres East of Broadway;
 - (d) Broadway, between Independence Square South and a point fifty metres South of Independence Square South;
 - (e) Independence Square South, on the southern side, from a point fifty metres East of Broadway to a point fifty metres West of Broadway;
 - (f) Chacon Street, on the western side, between Independence Square South and South Quay.

Parking
restricted

4. Parking is permitted on—
- (a) the Western Main Road, on the southern side, from a point fifty metres West of Luckput Street, to a point one hundred metres East of Link Road;
 - (b) Chacon Street, on the eastern side, between Independence Square South and South Quay except in the taxi stand.

Taxi Stand

5. Taxis plying—
- (a) for hire by tourists shall stand on Chacon Street, on the eastern side, between Independence Square South and South Quay, within the officially designated markings;
 - (b) the Arima and Sangre Grande routes shall stand on Independence Square South, on the northern side within the officially designated markings.

PART II

CUREPE

Taxi Stands

6. Taxis plying for hire on the Kelly Village route, shall stand on Evans Street, on the southern side, between the Southern Main Road and McDonald Street, facing West.

PART III

TUNAPUNA

Two-way
traffic

7. Drivers may proceed in either direction on the following roads:
- (a) Wilkinson Street, between Back Street and Clemency Street;
 - (b) Wilkinson Street, between Ranjit Street and Goviah Street;
 - (c) Wilkinson Street, between Clemency Street and Goviah Street.

PART IV

ARIMA

Maxi-taxi
Stand

8. Maxi-taxis plying for hire on the Port-of-Spain route via the Eastern Main Road, shall stand on Broadway, on the northern side, between Woodford Street and St. Joseph Street, facing West.

9. Drivers—
- (a) on Maingot Street, between El Carmen Street and Columbus Street, shall proceed in a southerly direction;
 - (b) on El Carmen Street, between Columbus Street and Maingot Street, shall proceed in a north-easterly direction.

PART V

SANGRE GRANDE

10. Drivers—

One-way
traffic

- (a) on Graham Trace, between Ojoe Road and Circular Road, from 7.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m., shall proceed in a westerly direction;
- (b) on Ramdass Street, between Brierley Street and the Eastern Main Road, shall proceed in a southerly direction.

11. Stopping, waiting or parking is prohibited on Graham Trace, on the northern side for thirty metres on either side of the gateways to the North Eastern College and the Sangre Grande Junior Secondary School.

12. Drivers proceeding in an easterly direction on the Eastern Main Road, shall turn left at Railway Road.

PART VI

MARABELLA

13. Taxis plying for hire on the Gasparillo route, shall stand on the Guaracara-Tabaquite Road, on the northern side, facing East, from a point forty-five metres East of the Southern Main Road.

PRINCES TOWN

14. Maxi-taxis proceeding East, along Tramline Street, may turn into Naparima-Mayaro Road.

PART VIII

RIO CLARO

15. Drivers on Grand Street, between Naparima-Mayaro Road and Cunapc Southern Main Road, shall proceed in a northerly direction, from 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m., Monday to Friday.

PART IX

SAN FERNANDO

16. Drivers on Queen Street approaching the roadway immediately East of the Bus Terminus, shall turn North, between the Bus Terminus and the Post Office and West into St. Vincent Street.

PART X

TOBAGO

Parking restricted

17. Parking is permitted on Store Bay Road, on the eastern side, between Store Bay Local Road and Milford Road.

Stopping, waiting, parking prohibited

18. Stopping, waiting or parking is prohibited on Store Bay Road, on the western side, between Store Bay Local Road and Milford Road.

One-way traffic

19. Drivers—

(a) on Store Bay Road, between Store Bay Local Road and Milford Road, shall proceed in a northerly direction;

(b) on Castries Street, between Carrington Street and Main Street, shall proceed in a southerly direction.

Two-way traffic

20. Drivers may proceed in either direction on All Fields Trace South and Spring Garden Branch Road at the Claude Noel Highway.

Taxi Stand

21. Route taxis plying for hire from Castries Street, shall stand on the eastern side, from a point three metres South of Carrington Street, facing South.

PART XI

GENERAL

Offence

22. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Order is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of five hundred dollars or to imprisonment for three months.

Removal and impounding of vehicles

23. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
