THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME)
(PORT-OF-SPAIN) REGULATIONS, 2001

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation
(Experimental Scheme) (Port-of-Spain) Regulations, 2001.

2. These Regulations have effect from Monday 11th June, 2001 to Commence-

3. Motorists may park on—

(a) George Street between Park Street and Independence
Square North on the eastern side between the hours
of 10.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. on Mondays, Wednesdays
and Fridays and on the western side between the hours of
10.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays;

(b) Charlotte Street between Park Street and Independence
Square North on the eastern side between the hours
of 10.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. on Mondays, Wednesdays
and Fridays and on the western side between the hours of
10.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays;

(c) Henry Street between Park Street and Independence
Square North on the eastern side between the hours of
10.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. on Mondays, Wednesdays and
Fridays on the western side between the hours of 10.00 a.m.
and 3.00 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays; and

(d) Chacon Street between Queen Street and Independence
Square North on the eastern side between the hours
of 10.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. on Mondays, Wednesdays
and Fridays and on the western side between the hours of
10.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

3. Motorists may park north on both sides on Saturdays on the following roads:

- (a) George Street between Park Street and Independence Square;
- (b) Charlotte Street between Park Street and Independence Square;
- (c) Henry Street between Park Street and Independence Square; and
- (d) Chacon Street between Queen Street and Independence Square.

4. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of these Regulations may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
