THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME)
(CUREPE) REGULATIONS, 2001

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control Citation
(Experimental Scheme) (Curepe) Regulations, 2001.
2. These Regulations shall have effect from Wednesday 25th July, Commence-

3. Any motorist may proceed on Evans Street, between Southern No entry to
Main Road and McDonald Street. taxis

4. Evans Street East shall be the minor road at its intersection Major and
with Clifford Street. minor roads
5. Drivers of maxi-taxis plying the route to Chaguanas, along Maxi-taxi
Southern Main Road, shall park— stand
 - (a) on the northern side of Havelock Street, between Southern
Main Road and Broome Street, facing east; or
 - (b) on the western side of Broome Street, between Havelock
Street and Fowler Street, facing north.
6. Motorists shall not park— No parking
 - (a) on Havelock Street, between Southern Main Road and
Market Street, on the southern side; and
 - (b) on Evans Street West, between Southern Main Road and
Broome Street, on the southern side.
7. Drivers of taxis, plying— Taxi stands
 - (a) any of the short routes, shall park on the northern side of
Evans Street East, facing west;

- (b) the route to San Fernando, shall park on the northernmost lane of Evans Street West, facing east;
- (c) the route to Chaguanas, shall park on the second lane of Evans Street West, facing east, adjacent to the northernmost lane of Evans Street West;
- (d) the route to Kelly Village or the route to Bamboo Village, shall park on the third lane of Evans Street West, facing east, adjacent to the second lane of Evans Street West; and
- (e) the route to Grand Bazaar, shall park on the eastern side of Broome Street, facing north, nine metres from Evans Street West.

No entry to

8. Drivers of maxi-taxis, plying the route to Chaguanas or the route to San Fernando, shall not enter any portion of Southern Main Road, between Evans Street and Havelock Street.

One-way
traffic

9. Motorists shall proceed in an easterly direction on Havelock Street, between Southern Main Road and Market Street.

Offence

10. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of these Regulations is liable on summary conviction for a first offence, to a fine of seven hundred and fifty dollars and on any subsequent conviction, to a fine of one thousand dollars.

Removal and
impounding

11. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a summary offence, vehicles found parked in contravention of these Regulations may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
