UNDER SECTION 67(1) OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC CONTROL (EXPERIMENTAL SCHEME)  
REGULATIONS, 2003

Citation 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Traffic Control  
(Experimental Scheme) Regulations, 2003.

Commence-  
ment and  
cessation 2. These Regulations shall have effect from Monday  
1st September, 2003 to Monday 1st December, 2003.

PART I

CUREPE

Maxi-taxi  
stands 3. Maxi-taxis that ply the Curepe to Chaguanas route shall ply on  
the northern and southern lanes of Havelock Street, facing east,  
between Southern Main Road and Broome Street.

No entry to  
maxi-taxis 4. Maxi-taxis that ply the Curepe to Chaguanas route shall not  
enter—

- (a) Southern Main Road, between Eastern Main Road and  
Havelock Street;
- (b) Broome Street, between Havelock Street and Evans Street;
- (c) Market Street, between Havelock Street and Evans Street;
- (d) Phillip Street, between Southern Main Road and McDonald  
Street;
- (e) Harris Street, between Southern Main Road and McDonald  
Street;
- (f) Clifford Street between Southern Main Road and McDonald  
Street;
- (g) McDonald Street, between Phillip Street and Evans Street;  
and
- (h) Evans Street East between Clifford Street and Southern  
Main Road.

One-way  
traffic 5. Motorists shall proceed in an easterly direction on Havelock  
Street between Southern Main Road and Broome Street.

PART II

ST. JOSEPH

6. Vehicles proceeding north along Uriah Butler Highway towards “U”-Turn Bamboo Settlement No. 3 or Grand Bazaar shall proceed to the intersection of Churchhill-Roosevelt Highway and Uriah Butler Highway and make a “U”-Turn at the intersection.

7. Vehicular traffic is prohibited on the local road north of Grand Bazaar at its intersection with Uriah Butler Highway. Road closed

8. Vehicular traffic exiting Grand Bazaar or Bamboo Settlement No. 3 shall not enter Uriah Butler Highway. No entry

9. Vehicular traffic proceeding south along Uriah Butler Highway shall not turn right into Bamboo Settlement No. 1. No right turn

PART III

EL SOCORRO

10. Parking is prohibited on El Socorro Road between Evelyn Trace and Lalla Street from 6.00 a.m to 7.00 p.m daily. Parking prohibited

PART IV

CHAGUANAS

11. From the hours of 6.00 a.m to 6.00 p.m from Monday to Friday, except on Public Holidays, motorist shall proceed— One-way traffic

- (a) in a westerly direction only on the Southern Main Road, Montrose, from its intersections with La Clave and De Verteuil Streets;
- (b) in a southerly direction only on La Clave Street between John Street and Southern Main Road;
- (c) in a northerly direction only on La Clave Street between Southern Main Road and Fitt Street;
- (d) in a northerly direction only on Smith Street between John Street and Southern Main Road; and
- (e) in a southerly direction only on Henry Street between John Street and Southern Main Road.

12. Vehicular traffic shall proceed—

- (a) in an easterly direction on Crown Trace, between Connection Drive and Southern Main Road; and
- (b) in a westerly direction on Connection Drive between Southern Main Road and Crown Trace.

One-way traffic

- No right turn      13. (1) Motorists proceeding west along the Chaguanas Main Road shall not turn right onto Caroni Savannah Road.
- (2) Motorists proceeding south along Caroni Savannah Road shall not turn right onto Chaguanas Main Road.
- Parking prohibited      14. Parking is prohibited on the eastern side of Railway Road between Ramsaran Street and Lalla Street.
- Loading and off-loading restricted      15. Delivery vehicles shall not load or off-load between the hours of 7.00 a.m to 9.00 p.m and 3.00 p.m to 5.00 p.m on—
- (a) Southern Main Road between Montrose Junction and Busy Corner; and
- (b) Chaguanas Main Road between Busy Corner and Marie Street.

## PART V

## CARONI

- Parking prohibited      16. Parking is prohibited on Caroni Savannah Road between Endeavour Connector Road and Munroe Road Interchange.

## PART VI

## CUNUPIA

- Taxi stand      17. Taxis that ply the Chin Chin Junction to Cunupia, and the Las Lomas and Mahaica routes shall ply on the southern paved area opposite Chin Chin Road.
- "U"-Turn      18. (1) Motorists proceeding along Southern Main Road shall not make a "U"-Turn at its intersection with Chin Chin Road.
- (2) Motorists proceeding along Chin Chin Road shall not make a "U"-Turn at its intersection with Southern Main Road.
- Parking prohibited      19. Parking is prohibited on the northern side of the road opposite Chin Chin Road.

## PART VII

## LONGDENVILLE

- One-way traffic      20. Motorists shall proceed in a northerly direction along St. Cyr Street between Longdenville Old Road and Depot Road.

PART VIII

COUVA

21. Motorists shall proceed in both directions on Isaac Street between Couva Main Road and Grant Street. Two-way traffic

PART IX

PENAL

22. Motorists shall proceed— One-way traffic
- (a) in a northerly direction on Olivere Drive from 2.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m. from Monday to Friday except on Public Holidays; and
  - (b) in a northerly direction on Ali Avenue from 2.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m. from Monday to Friday except on Public Holidays.

PART X

PRINCES TOWN

23. Motorists shall proceed in both directions on Buen Intento Road between Waterlane Street and Naparima-Mayaro Road. Two-way traffic

PART XI

ST. ANN'S

24. Parking is prohibited on— Parking prohibited
- (a) Ariapita Avenue between Light Pole No. 62 and Light Pole No. 64; and
  - (b) Hill Side Avenue, for fifty metres in either direction from the crest of the third bend.
25. Motorists proceeding to St. Ann's and Cascade from the Lady Young Road may proceed by way of the St. Ann's Roundabout. St. Ann's Roundabout

PART XII

MARAVAL

26. Motorists proceeding east on Rapsey Street shall not turn left onto Saddle Road during the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 8.30 a.m. Monday to Friday except on Public Holidays. No left turn

- One-way traffic
27. (1) From the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 8.30 a.m. from Monday to Friday except on Public Holidays, motorists shall proceed—
- (a) in an easterly direction only on Saddle Road between Long Circular Road and Rapsey Street;
  - (b) in a northerly direction only on Agra Street, between Patna and Delhi Streets;
  - (c) in an easterly direction only on Patna Street between Agra Street and Long Circular Road;
  - (d) in a southerly direction only on Long Circular Road between Patna Street and Delhi Street; and
  - (e) in a westerly direction only on Delhi Street between Circular Road and Calcutta Street.
- (2) Motorists shall proceed as follows:
- (a) in a westerly direction on Herbert Street;
  - (b) in a westerly direction on Rust Street; and
  - (c) in a southerly direction on Maraval Road between Marli Street and Tragarete Road;
- Two-way traffic
28. Vehicular traffic may proceed in both directions on Rapsey Street between Wainwright Street and Saddle Road during the hours of 6.00 a.m. to 8.30 a.m. from Monday to Friday except on Public Holidays.

## PART XIII

## DIEGO MARTIN

- Stopping or waiting prohibited
29. Vehicles are prohibited from stopping or waiting on—
- (a) Diego Martin Main Road for a distance of fifty metres both east and west of its intersection with St. Lucien Road;
  - (b) St. Lucien Road from its intersection with Diego Martin Main Road to a point fifty metres south;
  - (c) La Puerta Road to a point forty metres west of its intersection with Diego Martin Main Road;
  - (d) Rich Plain Road to a point forty metres west of its intersection with Diego Martin Main Road; and
  - (e) Covigne Road to a point forty metres west of its intersection with Diego Martin Main Road.
- Loading and off-loading restricted
30. Delivery vehicles shall not load or off-load on Diego Martin Main Road from 6.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m. from Monday to Friday.
- Parking prohibited
31. Parking is prohibited on—
- (a) Crystal Stream Road, between Diego Martin Main Road and Morne Coco Road; and
  - (b) Western Main Road, between St. James Link Road and Serpentine Road.

## PART XIV

## PORT-OF-SPAIN

32. Motorists may park on the following roads at the following <sup>Parking</sup> times:

- (a) Queen Street on the western side between George Street and Chacon Street from 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays and on the southern side from 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays;
- (b) Prince Street on the northern side between George Street and Henry Street from 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, and on the southern side from 10.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays;
- (c) George Street, between Prince Street and Independence Square North, on the eastern side, between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays and on the western side, between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays;
- (d) Charlotte Street, between Park Street and Independence Square North, on the eastern side, between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays and on the western side, between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays;
- (e) Henry Street between Park Street and Independence Square North, on the eastern side, between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays; and
- (f) Chacon Street between Queen Street and Independence Square North, on the eastern side, between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays and on the western side, between the hours of 10.00 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

33. Parking is prohibited on—

- (a) Albion Street;
- (b) Gordon Street, between St. Vincent Street and Dundonald Street; and
- (c) Park Street on the southern side between Victoria Square West and Victoria Square East.

<sup>Parking prohibited</sup>

34. Motorists may park on George Street between Duke Street and <sup>Alternate</sup> Prince Street on the eastern side on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays <sup>parking</sup> and on the western side on Tuesdays and Thursdays all day.

35. Motorists are prohibited on Sackville Street between Edward <sup>Vehicular</sup> Street and St. Vincent Street. <sup>traffic prohibited</sup>

## PART XV

## CARENAGE

- Parking 36. Motorists may not park their vehicles on Westland Avenue between the Western Main Road and Morne Coco Road.

## PART XVI

## CHAGUARAMAS

- Parking prohibited 37. Parking is prohibited on—  
 (a) Western Main Road, between the entrance to ALCOA Steamship Company Inc. and the entrance to the Cove;  
 (b) Marine Drive;  
 (c) Squadron Drive;  
 (d) Siren Drive;  
 (e) Tucker Valley Road, for a distance of two hundred metres north of Western Main Road;  
 (f) Airways Road.
- Left turn only 38. (1) Vehicular traffic proceeding south on Tucker Valley Road shall turn left at its intersection with the Western Main Road.  
 (2) Vehicular traffic proceeding south on Airways Road shall turn left at its intersection with the Western Main Road.  
 (3) Vehicular traffic proceeding north from the entrance to Pier 1 shall turn left at its intersection with the Western Main Road.
- No right turn 39. Vehicular traffic proceeding east on the Western Main Road shall not turn right at its intersection with Tucker Valley Extension Road and Airway Extension Road.
- Two-way traffic 40. Motorists may proceed in both directions on the access road traversing the east and westbound carriageways of the Western Main Road and opposite to the entrance of Pier 2.
- Speed limit 41. The speed limit on Tucker Valley Road is forty kilometres per hour.

## PART XVII

## SAN FERNANDO

- Parking prohibited 42. Parking is prohibited on the northern side of High Street between Chancery Lane and La Pique intersection.

43. Taxis plying for hire shall park as follows: Taxi stands
- (a) a maximum of ten taxis plying the San Fernando to Port-of-Spain route, facing east;
  - (b) a maximum of ten taxis plying the San Fernando to Curepe route, facing east;
  - (c) a maximum of ten taxis plying the San Fernando to Chaguanas route, facing east;
  - (d) a maximum of ten taxis plying the San Fernando to Gasparillo route, facing east;
  - (e) a maximum of ten taxis plying the San Fernando to Penal route, facing east; and
  - (f) a maximum of ten taxis plying the San Fernando to Barrackpore route, facing east; on the southern side of High Street, extending eastwards to La Pique intersection.

#### PART XVIII

##### SANGRE GRANDE

44. Taxis plying for hire shall park as follows: Taxi stands
- (a) taxis operating the Manzanilla, Plum Road and Sangre Chiquito routes shall park on the southern side of the Eastern Main Road near Republic Bank facing west, as marked;
  - (b) taxis operating on the Coalmine, Nestor, Biche, Guaico and Tamana routes shall park on the eastern side of the Cunapo Southern Road, near Jeremy's Video Club facing south, as marked;
  - (c) taxis operating on the Coryal, Four Roads, Tamana and Cumuto routes shall park on the eastern side of George Street, facing south, as marked;
  - (d) taxis operating on the Arima to Port-of-Spain routes shall park on the eastern side of Railway Road near Royal Castle facing south, as marked; and
  - (e) taxis operating on the Mayaro and Toco routes shall park on the eastern side of Railway Road near the Bus Terminus facing north, as marked.
45. Maxi-taxis plying for hire shall park as follows: Maxi-taxi stands
- (a) maxi-taxis operating on the Port-of-Spain to Sangre Grande route shall park on the southern side of Brierley Street, facing west, as marked; and
  - (b) maxi-taxis operating on the Toco and Mayaro routes shall park on the southern side of Brierley Street, facing east, as marked to accommodate three maxi-taxis.

46. Vehicular traffic shall proceed—

- (a) in a westerly direction on Brierley Street between Railway Road and River Street;
- (b) in a northerly direction on River Street between Brierley Street and Railway Road Extension;
- (c) in a southerly direction on Cunapo Southern Road from Andre Street to Juteram Street.
